## Your Goal!

## THE 3 ESSENTIALS PARTS:

1. Write about what your life was like before you repented of your sins. What is sin? How did you disobey God? List an example or two.
2. Write about how God changed your heart. How did you repent of your sins and follow Jesus? Where were you? What were you doing?
3. Write about how your life has changed since you believed. How is your life different now that you know Jesus? Please list an example or two.
